




Sensory Processing -A Guide For Parents

Nathalie Shek, Helping Kids Shine

Thursday, 20th of March 2025, 10:00am - 12:00pm

About the Session

In this session Nathalie will be exploring Sensory Processing and Integration and giving a basic understanding of sensory systems and regulation. The session will also include looking at practical ways to help children and young people with sensory processing and integration differences.

Topics covered include: the sensory systems, interoception, what is regulation, sensory ladders, and general advice.



Nathalie is an Advanced Practitioner Occupational Therapist working with children, young people, and families. Her clinical specialism is in working with neurodiverse families, with an interest in sensory processing, trauma, attachment, and how this impacts their daily lives.

Nathalie's qualifications include BSc (Hons) in Occupational Therapy, BSc (Hons) Sports Psychology, Postgraduate Certificate in Sensory Integration (Level 4), and a CLASI CASI Certificate in Ayres Sensory Integration.

Autism Family Support

Monmouthshire (AFS) provides
support and guidance to families
who have a family member
diagnosed or are looking for
support around autism

Who can access the Autism Family Support Service:

Any parent or carer living in Monmouthshire, who cares for a child who is or may be autistic.

Your child DOES NOT need to have a formal diagnosis to access the project. If you are concerned that your child may be autistic you can refer yourself for advice and support.

The Autism Family Support Service DOES NOT diagnose Autism or submit applications for diagnosis.



What the service offers:

Once you have registered with the service, one of the team will call you to discuss what support you are looking for. We will then arrange a follow-up meeting to chat through the available support.

- Monthly coffee & chat sessions
- Training workshops
- Monthly Newsletter
- Private FB group to access peer support and discussion
- Information about Monmouthshire Parent Carer Events
- 1:1 support for parent/carer which may include sharing of resources, offer of strategies/advice for managing particular behaviours, guidance through the process of getting a diagnosis.




